

Community Grants

As part of our commitment to make a positive contribution to the local community, we have established the Granville Harbour Wind Farm *Volunteer Emergency Services Grant*. The Grant provides project funding to West Coast-based Emergency Services units to assist them protect and preserve the safety of the local community.

Guidelines

Geographical area

The *Volunteer Emergency Services Grant* will specifically target the West Coast region of Tasmania. Consideration will be given to Volunteer Emergency Services units based in Zeehan, Queenstown, Rosebery, Strahan and Tullah. Emphasis will also be given to North West Tasmanian Emergency Services initiatives targeted specifically at improving the safety of West Coast residents.

Funding priorities

Applications for funding are invited for one or more of the following focus areas:

- provide for the purchase of new emergency services equipment
- allow for minor facilities improvements at Emergency Services facilities
- assist emergency services to design and run community safety education and awareness events
- support the training and skill development of emergency services *volunteers*
- contribute to the implementation of new community risk prevention measures.

Applications will be reviewed against the following selection criteria:

- *The organisation:* The organisation is a recognised volunteer Emergency Services unit based within the West Coast of Tasmania – or provides specific services to the West Coast.
- *Social Issue:* Requested funds will be utilised specifically for improving the safety of West Coast residents or to enhance the capacity of Emergency Services to adequately respond to emergency incidents in the West Coast region.
- *Funding:* The proposal clearly outlines how funds will be utilised. The bulk of funding requested is not available from other sources – including operational budgets.
- *Measures:* There are measures and resources in place to deliver and evaluate project success.

General rules

We do not support:

- Initiatives which would normally receive funding as part of core budget.
- Commercial or advertising requests.
- Applications that have been previously been rejected.
- Applications from outside the geographical area.

Applications

Application dates for the 2021 Granville Harbour Wind Farm Volunteer Emergency Services Grant are open and applications will be assessed on a case by case basis until annual funds are expended.

Applications will be assessed based on their ability to address the selection criteria as well as the perceived benefit to the local community. All applications must meet the eligibility criteria and comply with the Terms and Conditions.
